Assessment Policy & Procedure

Year 8

Assessment tasks are an integral component of student learning. In the interests of equity for all students the following rules and procedures apply to all formal assessment tasks.

The school's procedure for the submission of assessment tasks is as follows:

Task Information and Submission

- 1. Assessment task notifications will be issued at least two weeks prior to the due date.
- 2. Students must sign an assessment registration sheet upon receiving the assessment task notification.
- 3. Assessment task notification sheets should be glued into a student's workbook where appropriate.
- 4. All assessment tasks must be completed/submitted on the due date, during the set lesson.
- 5. Tasks must be submitted to the classroom teacher, (or the Head Teacher, if the classroom teacher is absent).

Lateness/Absence/Extension Request

- **6.** Assessment tasks that are submitted **late will incur a penalty**. A penalty **of 20% per day** of the total mark will be deducted for late tasks a weekend will incur a 20% late penalty.
- 7. If a student is away on the due date, an explanatory letter from a parent, care giver must be submitted to the classroom teacher **on the student's first day back at school**. It will be the decision of the Head Teacher if a penalty is to be imposed.
- 8. A student who fails to complete an in-class assessment task on the due date will be required to complete the task in an alternate time arranged by the Head Teacher to achieve the course outcomes. It may include Tuesday period 6.
- 9. Requests for extensions prior to the due date must be made to the *Head Teacher* by the parent. *All extensions will only be approved with evidence of exceptional circumstance.*

Assessment Task Problems

- Students are to notify their teacher of any assessment problems in advance of the due date.
- 11. Students are not to use technology failure as a reason for failing to hand in assessment tasks.
- 12. Assessment tasks must be submitted in the format specified in the task. It is the student's responsibility to ensure that their work is printed before the due date.

13. Alternate arrangements for speeches or presentations will only be considered when accompanied by medical documentation.

Malpractice

- 14. Malpractice is defined as any activity that allows students to gain an unfair advantage over other students. It includes but is not limited to:
 - Copying someone else's work in part or in whole and presenting it as a student's own;
 - Using material directly from books, journals, CDs or the internet without reference to the source;
 - Submitting work to which another person such as a parent, tutor, or subject expert has contributed to substantially;
 - Buying, stealing or borrowing another person's work and presenting it as a student's own;
 - Contriving false explanations for work not submitted by the due date; or
 - Building on the ideas of another person's work and presenting it as a student's own.

If malpractice is proven a mark of zero may be awarded for the task and an 'Official Warning' letter will be issued to the student. The student may be required to complete an alternate or the same task.

Notification of Parents

15. Parents will be notified in writing if students fail to meet assessment task requirements.

Points to remember

- ✓ Practical Assessment does NOT require written work or research time.
- ✓ Assessment dates may change because of changes to school routine not known at the time
 of publication.
- ✓ Students will be adequately notified of any changes to the assessment schedule, dates and tasks.

Note to Students and Parents

For the 2020 final report the weightings will be converted to a percentage.
